

# Changes to the list of Statements of Principles, August 2018

On 14 August 2018 changes were made to the list of Australian Statements of Principles that apply in New Zealand. The Statements of Principles are a tool to determine if an injury, illness or death is service-related.

Gazette notice number 2018-gs4041 will amend the Statements of Principles that cover:

- malignant neoplasm of the pancreas—reasonable hypothesis version only
- lumbar spondylosis
- thoracic spondylosis
