If you served in Viet Nam you may be able to have a free medical assessment every year.

## Who can get this

You may be able to get an Annual Medical Assessment (AMA) if you have Qualifying Operational Service in Viet Nam.

This allows you to have a free medical assessment from a medical practitioner every year.

### 1 Complete the form

To apply for an Annual Medical Assessment, you need to complete the Viet Nam veteran registration form.
